The Event will be conducted under the *National Competition Rules (NCRs)* of the *Australian Auto-Sport Alliance (AASA)*, these Supplementary Regulations, and any further regulations and bulletins which may be issued.

**Event Schedule:** A compulsory drivers briefing will be held in the Service Park at 09:00.  
First car will start at 10:00 and thereafter at a minimum of two-minute intervals.  
Competition will cease no later than 18:00 with a presentation of awards following as soon as possible.

**Event Format:** There will be **two (2)** gravel stages of approx. **6 km** in length, that will be run a **minimum four (4)** times each.  
A road book for each stage will be supplied.

- Entries:** Entries open on publication of these regulations and close at **18:00, 27th Saturday 24<sup>th</sup> March 2024**  
Entries will be capped at 20. Entry numbers may be altered at the discretion of the organisers.
- Entry Fee:** The entry fee is **\$275 incl gst. per driver** (max 2 drivers per car) and must be paid by Direct Deposit:

**Reference must be your full name.** Your entry will not be accepted until a fully completed entry form and payment is received.  
A discount of \$20 applies if you are a financial member of the Wide Bay Motor Complex.

Indemnity forms are also available on the web site and **must be completed and returned to the event secretary before the close of entries.**

- Licences:** This event is open to those competitors holding a current **AASA General Speed Event** or **Gravel Rally Licence**.  
Motorsport Australia licences are no longer accepted.  
Juniors wishing to compete must be **14 yrs** of age and hold the a AASA Junior General Speed Licence.

- Classes:** Rear Wheel Drive,  
Front Wheel Drive,  
Four Wheel Drive  
Buggies (both 4wd and 2wd)  
Juniors
- Trophies:** Trophies will be awarded for 1st, 2nd & 3rd in each class.  
Where there are less than 3 entries in the class, only 1st will be awarded.

- Abandonment:** The organisers reserve the right to postpone or cancel the event if a minimum of 10 entries are not reached, or due to inclement weather.  
In both these instances your entry fee will be refunded in full.
- Insurance:** Personal Accident Insurance is provided under the AASA permit.

- Apparel:** Each crew member's apparel must conform to [AASA, NCR Appendices, Appendix 4 - Apparel Requirements Policy, 5.2 Speed Events and Drifting - General Speed](#). (Non-flammable apparel that covers the person from mid-neck to wrist to ankles).  
Although not mandatory, Frontal Head Restraints (FHR) such as HANS are strongly recommended.  
Apparel will be visually checked by the Control Officials before each car starts.
- Vehicle Requirements:** Vehicles must comply with the *AASA National Competition Rules (NCRs)* that can be found at [www.aasa.com.au](http://www.aasa.com.au).
- Each vehicle must:**
- Carry a fire extinguisher of minimum 1 kg firmly bolted into the driving compartment and be accessible by both crew members. **Extinguishers must be in date and show no damage.**
  - Carry 2 reflective Safety Triangles easily accessible by both crew members.
  - Have mudflaps of a stout material on all driving wheels.
  - Have front and rear tow points clearly marked.
  - Carry a SOS / OK board which must be displayed to all following cars in case of mechanical failure or accident.
  - Be fitted with roll over protection that complies to Class 1 (half cage) as a minimum requirement. [AASA, NCR Appendices, Appendix 1 – Safety Cage Regulations Policy, 2.1 General, 2.1.1 - Class 1](#).
- Vehicles do not require a AASA Vehicle Passport but if issued, it must be presented at scrutineering.
- An in-car distance measuring device (trip meter) accurate to 1 metre is strongly recommended.

<b>Scrutiny:</b>	Scrutiny will start at <b>07:30</b> in the refuel bay area. Vehicles that do not pass scrutiny will not be allowed to start until the defects noted have been repaired. If your vehicle fails scrutiny, no refund of entry fee will be given.
<b>Documentation:</b>	Documentation will commence at <b>08:00</b> . All competitors must present their licences to the Event Secretary for inspection.
<b>Crew:</b>	<p>The crew will consist of a driver and co-driver holding the applicable licences. Running without a co-driver is only permitted in single seat buggies. Passengers are not permitted.</p> <p>Unlike previous events, minimal arrows will be used with an emphasis on co-driver participation.</p>
<b>Service Crew:</b>	All service crew members must be registered on the official entry form.
<b>Refuelling:</b>	<p>Refuelling must only be carried out in the designated area and any person involved must wear non-flammable clothing and closed shoes.</p> <p>The closest pump fuel is 5 minutes away at the BP in Granville.</p> <p>Fuel must only be stored in 20L containers that meet AS1940/AS/NZS2906 or higher in order to comply with OH&amp;S requirements and the <i>Dangerous Goods Act 1985</i>.</p>
<b>Timing:</b>	<p>Electronic timing equipment will be used.</p> <p><b>It is the competitors' responsibility to be on time at the start controls and penalties may apply for late arrival.</b></p>
<b>Protests:</b>	These events are fun events and <b>No protests will be entered into.</b>
<b>Smoking:</b>	Smoking in the Service Area is prohibited, a smoking area will be designated
<b>Facilities:</b>	<p>Toilets and hot showers are available.</p> <p>Free camping (non-powered) is available on-site from Friday lunch time.</p>
<b>Catering:</b>	<p>Food and drinks will be available Saturday breakfast and lunch.</p> <p>Dinner on Saturday night - TBA.</p>
<b>Rubbish:</b>	All visitors to the site are responsible for the removal of their own rubbish.

## Drugs and Alcohol:

Consumption of alcohol by drivers, co-drivers or crew is forbidden prior to the completion of the event in accordance [AASA National Competition Rules \(NCRs\)](#), [Schedule 3 – List of Prohibited Substances](#) & [AASA Supplementary Regulations – Rally Sprint, 14 – Drugs & Alcohol](#).

**All competitors must not have a blood alcohol reading above 0.01**

All competitors and Officials are advised that random drug and alcohol testing may take place during the event. Any driver or crew found to be under the influence of alcohol or recreational drugs during the event will be excluded from the event and further penalties may be imposed in accordance with the NCRs.
